



Introduction

Castlebar Municipal District governs the town of Castlebar and the general Castlebar area. It has a population of 30,000 and has 28 Electoral Divisions.

There are 7 elected Members in Castlebar Municipal District since the Local Elections in June 2019 and they meet on the last Wednesday of every month to discuss the development and implementation of policies across a broad range of areas. The members work closely with the Director of Service, Head of Municipal District, the Senior Executive Engineer and the support staff of Mayo County Council to ensure that the Castlebar area continues to thrive, both socially and economically.

The town of Castlebar is actively twinned with Höchstadt in Germany, Auray in France, and in the USA, Dixon, Illinois, Westchester, New York State and Peekshill, also in New York State. These are seen as important cultural links.

Lime Bikes

The official launch of the lime shared e-bikes took place in Lucan Street, Castlebar on the 22nd September by Cathaoirleach Cllr. Michael Kilcoyne and also in attendance are Cllr. B. Gavin and Cllr. G. Deere.

Lime – the world's largest shared e-bike and scooter provider – has announced the launch of its 12-month shared e-bike pilot in Castlebar.

The scheme was delivered in partnership with Mayo County Council and will see up to 100 bikes available for hire in virtual parking bays across the town.

Castlebar is the first Irish town to welcome Lime's shared e-bikes, marking the company's official launch here. Ireland is the 36th country to have launched Lime's vehicles globally, with the provider operating services in more than 250 cities around the world.



Park & Stride

The Park and Stride scheme for schools, children and parents took place at Castlebar Primary School on the 21st September 2022 by Cathaoirleach Cllr. Michael Kilcoyne and also in attendance is Cllr. B. Gavin.

This Scheme means leaving the car about 10 minutes' walk from the school gate, and making the last leg of the journey to school on foot. For parents or grandparents doing the walk to and from the car, that's 15–20 minutes towards the recommended 30 minutes of physical exercise we should all be doing every day.

Town & Village Renewal Scheme

Straide Village Enhancements

Grant funding was awarded to Mayo County Council under the Town & Village Renewal Scheme

The proposed project was to carry out enhancements to Straide Village and particularly to the Fair Green and setting of the **Michael Davitt Museum.** The Fair Green, provides a pleasant setting to the Museum, The Abbey, the Straide River with its arched stone bridge and the Church of St. Peter and Paul. Works included:

- 1. Removal and undergrounding of unsightly overhead ESB power lines.
- 2. Removal of unused hard paved areas.
- 3. Grass reinstatement.
- 4. Resurfacing works to old road.
- 5. Paving works to footways.
- 6. New public lighting.
- 7. Railings and Street furniture.



Breaffy Woodland Trails

Grant funding was awarded to Mayo County Council under the Town & Village Renewal Scheme

This project was carried out by Mayo County Council in partnership with Coillte, Breaffy Community Council and Breaffy Resort Hotel. The project extended and upgraded existing trails to deliver a pleasant looped Woodland Walk measuring over 2km.



During 2022, a new Greenway access point was developed in Turlough village. It consisted of a new bridge installation and a 400 metres access link, of a dedicated path for walking and cycling. Funding for this project was made available from the Department of Rural Community Development & Mayo County Council

Islandeady Bridge



The official opening of the Islandeady Bridge took place on the 25th May, 2022 by Cathaoirleach Cllr. Martin McLoughlin also in attendance are Cllr. G. Deere, Cllr. M. Kilcoyne, Cllr. B. Gavin.

The Islandeady pedestrian bridge construction was carried out under an Active Travel scheme funded by the NTA. The scheme included the installation of a metal frame wooden deck prefabricated bridge crossing the river adjacent to Islandeady church. The scheme also included upgrading the public lighting and constructing a new footpath to create a continuous pedestrian link from the sports grounds to the Islandeady church and community facilities.

Castlebar Urban Greenway Link Project



Grant approval was secured through the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage under the Urban Regeneration Development Fund Scheme (URDF) to complete the remaining urban section of the Great Western Greenway through Castlebar i.e. Bridge Street to Springfield (Turlough Trailhead) and including the Military Barracks connection and Lower Charles Street.





The Claremorris - Swinford Municipal District Serves:

- One third of the County's population
- One third of the County's elected representatives
- Almost two fifths of the total road network
- Seven of the twelve towns in the County with a population greater than 1,000

It consists of the Claremorris Electoral Area, with 6 elected representatives, and the Swinford Electoral Area, with 4 elected representatives. 11 Meetings were held in 2022 including the Annual General Meeting, which took place on 6th July 2022. Councillor John Cribben was elected Cathaoirleach and Councillor Michael Burke was elected Leas-Cathaoirleach.



2022 HIGHLIGHTS

- Active Travel Grants in the amount of circa €1.8 million were provided to the Claremorris-Swinford Municipal District.
- The Ballinrobe Urban Greenway commenced and will be progressed over the next number of years, with an amount of circa €225,000 allocated.
- Charlestown Riverwalk also commenced, with an allocation of €176,000 being provided, which will link the outdoor swimming pool to the GAA Pitch. This project is due for completion in 2023.
- A cycle lane was completed at Chapel Lane, Claremorris, costing €439,322, and a cycle lane and footpath at Claremount Rd., Claremorris, at a cost of €668,068.
- An extension of the footpath on the Neale Rd. to Ballinrobe Burial Ground was completed. Also achieved were extensions of the footpath in Kilmaine town to the GAA Pitch for €105,000, and a path in Glencorrib for an amount of €95,000.
- The ORIS Greenway Project was completed at Bellass Rd., Foxford, for circa €300,000.
- Houses were allocated to families and individuals on the Council's waiting list at the newly constructed Housing Developments in Hollymount and Charlestown.
- The Climate Adaption and Resilience works scheme for circa €362,000, allowed for remedial works at more than twenty locations in the Municipal District.
- Bohola CLÁR scheme involved the creation of an orchard of native plants/trees and a sensory garden within the existing community park along with a covered outdoor community space, benches, picnic and barbeque areas.
- Four Community Involvements Schemes were undertaken at Lisloughrey, Abbeyquarter, Aughamore and Midfield at a value of circa €420,000.

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General Municipal Allocation (GMA)

□ €700,000 GMA funding was allocated by the Claremorris-Swinford Municipal District in 2022. This funding was distributed between Capital and Community Projects. The elected members funded applications for Grant Aid for Residents Associations, Clubs/Community Organisations, Festivals/Events and Burial Ground Committees. A budget of €60,000 was allocated to 53 Burial Ground Committees in 2022.

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Road Transportation and Safety

Over €13 million funding was expended under the 2022 Roads Works Scheme in Claremorris - Swinford Municipal District.

National Roads

- Construction works were completed on the N26 Cloongullaun Bridge at a total cost of circa of €20 million.
- The N17-R320 Lisduff Junction upgrade construction works commenced, with a total cost circa of €10 million
- A total budget of €272,000 was availed of for National Road Maintenance

Regional Roads

€2.3 million was expended for regional road maintenance, surface restoration and strengthening works.

Local Roads

€10.7 million was availed of for local road maintenance, surface restoration and strengthening works.

WESTPORT-BELMULLET MUNICIPAL DISTRICT

Monthly Municipal District meetings take place on the last Monday of the month and meetings normally alternate between Westport and Belmullet. The Members work with the Director of Services, Head of Municipal District and all the staff in the Municipal District to support communities in the Municipal District, to improve and maintain infrastructure and to seek funding opportunities for projects which benefit our area from a social or economic prospective.




