#### TOPOGRAPHY

This parish contains very little of interest to the tourist and in the scenic sense, holds few attractions. An outstanding view is that obtained from Farm Hill, the residence of Rev. Fr. Davis, P.P.; from here, the naked eye beholds many miles of level plain and the surrounding mountain barriers. Historic Killala appears to be but a couple of miles distant and further east, Enniscrone with its magnificent strand may be recognised without difficulty.

Ballina is about thirteen miles from the post office at Kincon, Crossmolina, twelve miles, Ballycastle seven and Killala four miles.
