Roads

Environmental Awareness:

- Throughout the Summer months MCC partnered with Leave no Trace to run a social media campaign 'love this place, leave no trace'. This campaign, aimed at day trippers and tourists, encouraged care for the fragile environment in many of our scenic and coastal areas.

Enterprise & Economic Development Unit
