




Kilmaine Loop Walks



The Killernan Walk

Start/Finish Point: Centra carpark, Kilmaine
 Distance: 5 kms
 Estimated Time: 1.5 - 2 hours
 Trail Waymarking: Trail is waymarked with a black post, 1m high, with a red directional arrow
 Terrain: Gravel Tracks and Country Lanes
 Level of Difficulty: Easy/Moderate
 Theme: Nature/Country Walk
 Description: Take the path towards the graveyard and continue towards Killernan Castle, the scene of a famous duel between Brown of the Neale and Millar of Milford in 1747.

The Church Walk

Start/Finish Point: Centra carpark, Kilmaine
 Distance: 3 kms
 Estimated Time: 45 min - 1 hour
 Trail Waymarking: Trail is waymarked with a black post, 1m high with a blue directional arrow
 Terrain: Gravel Tracks and Country Lanes
 Level of Difficulty: Easy/Moderate
 Theme: Nature/Country Walk
 Description: Follow the blue arrows to St. Patrick's Church, home of 'The Nativity', the beautiful Harry Clarke designed stained glass window.

The Nature Walk

Start/Finish Point: Centra carpark, Kilmaine
 Distance: 1.2 kms
 Estimated Time: 20 - 30 min
 Trail Waymarking: Trail is waymarked with a black post, 1m high, with a green directional arrow
 Terrain: Gravel Tracks and Country Lanes
 Level of Difficulty: Easy/Moderate
 Theme: Nature/Country Walk
 Description: This is an idyllic short walk to suit all levels of fitness.
