Situated on the main Clanmorris/Inch road, 4 3/4 M. from the tower and 13 from Kletter. Ournore & Lishtown 2 3/4 M.

A village of a single street running approx. N.W. to S.E. which is about 300 yds. long and which contains some 25 houses both sides - church and school being also to south-west side at north-west end. Off the street one road leads north and another south - a few houses lie at their terminations. The main street is wide but is lined for only main road width - the sides next is stony. The houses are almost all two-story of varying height. There is a few stone blocks. Two single-story houses are thatched. Some of the houses are well-painted - others dull.

St. Joseph's Catholic Church: nave and chancel north & south transepts and chancel. Chancel (rectangular) has window of 3 pointed lights in pt. arch with light interior mould. Side apses pointed with interior mould. Transepts have plain pointed windows of two lights. Plain pt. doorway. nave windows plain pointed with interior mould. West doorway plain round head in recess with arched 2 light ykt. window also. Small vestry of chancel which has corner buttresses (2) each buttress bears a statue.
