

**HISTORIC SITES**

St. Patrick spent a considerable time in the Aghagower district and having erected his church here, consecrated the pious Saint Senach or Sionnach - Fox, as bishop. He named Sionnach the "Lamb of God".

*At the wild and lonely mouth  
Near the entrance to the Aille Caves, a large boulder is pointed out  
as a Mass Stone of the Penal Days. It is said that St. Patrick  
celebrated Mass at Bille, presumably at or near this spot.*
