FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

- **Tuesday: St. Ailbe, bishop.** He founded a monastery at Emly in Tipperary which became very important in Munster. He died in 528.
- Wednesday: St. John Chrysostom, bishop and doctor of the church (347-407). He was archbishop of Constantinople. He was such a wonderful preacher that he was called 'golden-mouthed'. He is the patron saint of preachers
- **Thursday:** The Triumph of the Cross. The discovery of the True Cross by St. Helena is dated to 14th September 320. This event has been celebrated ever since in praise of the redemption won for us by Christ.
- Friday: Our Lady of Sorrows. As Jesus offered himself to his Father on Calvary Mary stood by His side and suffered with Him.
- Saturday: Sts. Cornelius, pope and martyr and Cyprian, bishop and martyr. St. Cornelius became pope in 251 and died in exile in 253. St. Cyprian was bishop of Carthage and was martyred in 258. They were close friends.
