

PARISH NEWS

ADVENT AND THE ADVENT WREATH:

The third Sunday of Advent was once called 'Gaudete (rejoice) Sunday', from the first word of the Entrance Antiphon at Mass. On this day rose coloured vestments may be worn at Mass to indicate the joyous note in the liturgy. For the same reason the pink candle is lit on the Advent Wreath along with the two purple candles representing the first two Sundays of Advent.

In today's Gospel John the Baptist announces the coming of the Messiah, Jesus Christ – 'someone is coming after me, someone who is more powerful that I am and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals'.

During the final eight days of Advent, ie from the 17th to 24th December, the events that happened immediately before the Lord's birth are presented in the Gospel at Mass each day. The first reading in the Mass each day gives the principal prophecies that refer to the Messiah or Saviour.

Mary Kelly on behalf of the Pastoral Council will light the third candle on the Advent Wreath at 7.00pm Mass in Fahy.

Tracy O'Donnell on behalf of the Folk Choir will light the third candle on the Advent Wreath at the 11.30am Mass in Myna.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

Monday

St. Finnian, bishop. He established a famous monastery and school in Clonard, Co. Meath. Among his pupils were Canice, Colum Cille and Brendan. He died in 549 and is remembered as the tutor of the saints of Ireland.

Our Lady of Guadalupe. When we reflect on the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe we learn two important lessons, one of faith and one of understanding

Tuesday:

St Lucy, virgin & martyr. She was martyred in 304 in Sicily in the persecution of Diocletian. Her name means 'light' and her intercession has been sought for eye trouble.

Wednesday:

St. John of the Cross, priest and doctor of the Church (1542-1591). He was a Carmelite who worked for the reform of the Carmelite order. He was a man of prayer, an outstanding poet and a

spiritual writer.
