FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

great monastery of St. Gallen. He died in 670.

Tuesday: St. Ignatius of Antioch, bishop and martyr. He wrote important

documents on the faith. He was martyred in Rome about 107.

Wednesday: St. Luke, evangelist. He was a physician from a gentile Christian

background. He accompanied St. Paul on his second missionary journey and during his imprisonment in Rome. He wrote his Gospel

and The Acts of the Apostles.

Thursday: St. Paul of the Cross.
