Derrinumera Landfill site,
Castlebar – Newport Road (R311) - F28 TF89
[approx. 13kms from Castlebar]



Rathroeen Landfill Site,
Killala Road, Ballina (R364) - F26 TF29
[approx. 5kms from Ballina]



Please observe the 5km/h speed limit.

Children enjoy helping out with recycling and are very welcome, but please take care as there is a lot of moving traffic at the centres.

Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.

If you bring pets they must be kept in your vehicle.

COMPOST BINS

Home composting bins are available for sale from both recycling centres. They can be purchased for the subsidised cost of €30 which includes an information booklet and a kitchen caddy.

MAYO COUNTY COUNCIL'S RECYCLING CENTRES

The centres which are for household use only, consist of a series of clearly labelled skips and banks where recyclable items can be deposited.

Mayo County Council carries out baling of some recyclable items on site and all the items are then transported by permitted waste collectors to end markets, where the actual recycling process takes place.

The recycling centres also contain an area for the collection of household hazardous waste. This waste is forwarded for recycling or safe disposal.

We also accept household waste for disposal. This waste will then be collected from our centres by a permitted waste collector, and moved off site for final disposal.

SOME SIMPLE RULES!

- Remove all caps, corks and rings from glass bottles, jars, plastic bottles and Tetra Pak cartons.
- Rinse out and drip dry all containers before coming to centres.
- Electrical goods must be cleaned of all food contamination.
- Deep fat fryers must be free of oil.
- Dust bags must be removed from vacuum cleaners before recycling.
- As charges apply, bring a method of payment with you. Creditcard, cash, cheque are all accepted but please don't ask for credit!

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Mayo County Council will accept all items of household hazardous waste provided that the containers are clearly labelled and that all waste is stored in original containers.

No sharps (used needles etc) accepted

cleaning agents	motor oil	oil filters
oil contaminated packaging	pesticides	medicine
veterinary medicine	paints	aerosols
gas cylinders	fire extinguishers	printer cartridges

NON-RECYCLABLE/GENERAL WASTE

There are two options for bringing non-recyclable/general waste to the centres.

- Bags of waste can be brought to centres and paid for individually.
- Waste can be weighed in your vehicle on the weigh bridge and you pay per weight for your waste. A minimum charge applies to this option.
- Pillows, cushions, duvets and sleeping bags can only be accepted for disposal.
