Tuesday: St. Januarius, was beheaded, with his Companions, at

Pozzuoli in A.D. 305 by Diocletian for refusing to worship

pagan idols. He is the Patron Saint of Naples.

Wednesday St. Andrew Kim Taegon and Companions, martyrs.

They were Koreans martyred between 1839-1867.
