FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

- Monday:** **St. Augustine (354-430), bishop & doctor of the church.** He was St. Monica's son. He became bishop of Hippo after his conversion. His theological influence on Christianity has been enormous, especially on the difficult subject of God's grace.
- Tuesday:** **The Passion of St. John the Baptist, martyr.** He was the precursor of Jesus Christ and pointed him out to his own followers as the Messiah. He died a martyr's death – his last and greatest act of witness to Jesus Christ.
- Wednesday:** **St. Fiachre.** He went to France and set up a hermitage in Meaux. There is still great devotion to him in France.
- Thursday:** **St. Aidan of Lindisfarne.** He was a monk of Iona. He was very successful in converting the people of Northumbria. He died in 651.
