TRAFFIC DISRUPTION

Week Commencing 6th May 2024

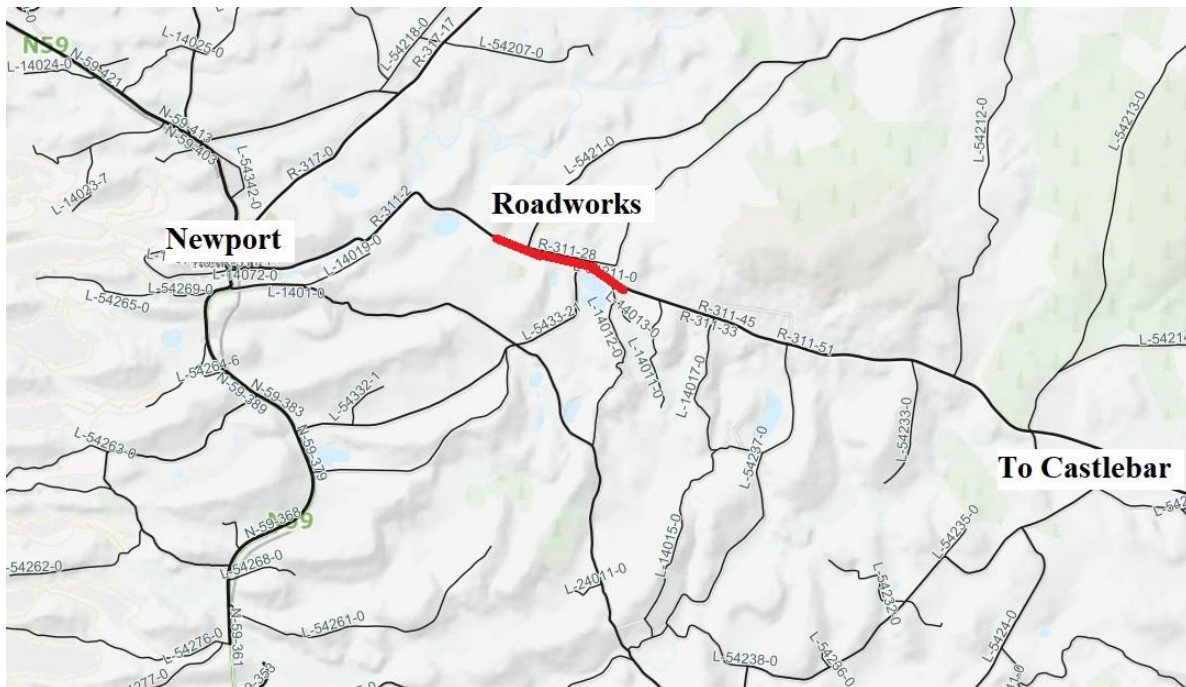
Castlebar Municipal District:

- **N60 Balla to Claremorris (Heathlawn) Road Project Traffic Management**
 - *60 KM/HR roadworks speed limit in place on the N60 for approx. 4.3 KM, East bound starting in the townland of Pollavaddy, through the townlands of Garhawnagh, Carrowgarve, Rathduff, Heathlawn, Brees, Ballintleva, and ending in the townland of Barnagreggaun.*
 - *VMS boards in place on N60, both East bound and West bound – 60 km/hr speed limit and project works.*
 - *24-hour traffic management/traffic signals in operation, single line traffic control, delays expected.*
- **Surfacing Works on the N5 Ballyvary to Bohola Road at Knockatemple are due to commence on Monday 22nd April 2024 for a period of approximately 5 weeks.**
 - *Traffic management including traffic lights and a Stop / Go system will be in place during daytime working hours.*
 - *Eastbound traffic (From Castlebar) will be advised to divert in Ballyvary via N58 Ballyvary to Ballylahan, and R321 onto Bohola during working hours. Local Traffic / emergency vehicles etc will be accommodated.*

From Tuesday 7th May, in addition to traffic lights and a Stop / Go system on the N5 at Bohola, intermittent traffic diversions will be in place on the R321 at Kiltimagh (via R320) and at Ballylahon Bridge (via N58) for traffic wishing to access the N5 at Bohola. These restrictions will be in place periodically during daytime working hours for approximately 2 weeks. Local Traffic / emergency service vehicles etc will be accommodated

Westport Belmullet Municipal District:

- Footpath and pedestrian facility works – N59 Newport – George’s St. and Quay Rd. - 150m;
 - *Traffic management in operation, speed restrictions and periodic single line traffic control.*



- Stop/Go traffic management will be in place on the R-311 Newport to Castlebar Road at Cuilmore for resurfacing works from Wednesday the 8th to Friday the 10th of May.

Claremorris Swinford Municipal District:

- Site investigation works are scheduled to be carried out on Davitt Place R375, Station Road, Circular Road L1330 and the N26 Main Street in Swinford town as part of the EIRGRID project. The works are scheduled to take place from Monday the 22nd April for a week, with works commencing in the evenings from 6pm.
 - *A traffic management plan will be in place, please expect delays and allow extra time for your journey. Please note that some parking restrictions will be in place during the works also.*

Ballina Municipal District:

- Road pavement works and footpath rehabilitation works are continuing on the R314 in Killala.

- *Major Roadworks starting on Market Street, Killala 15th April.*
- *Church Street will be opened to two way traffic managed by traffic lights.*
- *HGV's diversions in place.*

- **Road pavement works, R314 Killala Rd (Merry Monk & Gillespie's Garage).**
 - *Traffic management in operation, speed restrictions and single line traffic control.*

- **Ballina Town Centre – Irish Water, Watermain replacement works**
 - *Pearse St - Road will be open to traffic as usual. Diversion of HGV's from the town centre will be necessary.*
 - *Dillion Tce / Humbert St - Nightworks shall commence soon. Temporary traffic management will be in operation. Please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey.*
 - *Pawn office lane – Closed to foot traffic to facilitate ongoing water main replacement works*

- **Roadworks ongoing on the R310 – Ballina to Knockmore**
 - *Traffic Controls will be in Operation – Driver caution is advised*

- **N59 Ballina Town – Lord Edward St. and Teeling St.; for ~ 0.5km; Mon. to Thurs., Night-time works from 7pm**
 - *Traffic management in operation, speed restrictions and single line traffic control with local diversions.*

- **Roadworks will commence on the L1107 at Tooreen**
 - *Traffic Management including Traffic lights in operation, caution advised.*
