PARISH NEWS

THE EASTER SEASON:

The fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday are celebrated as one feastday, sometimes called "The Great Sunday". The singing of the 'Alleluia' expresses the characteristic joy of these days. The continuous readings from St. John's Gospel on weekdays give us the understanding of Our Lord seen in the light of his resurrection and glorification. A continuous reading from the Acts of the Apostles shows us the Church of the Risen Lord now filled with his Spirit and continuing his work.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY:

This Sunday, 16th April, is Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast was instituted by Pope John Paul II following revelations to Sr. Faustina of Poland. In the Word "mercy" he summed up and interpreted anew for our time the whole mystery of Redemption. He had lived under two dictatorial regimes and his contact with poverty, neediness and violence he had a profound experience of the powers of darkness which also threaten us today. But he had an equally strong experience of the presence of God who opposed all these forces with his power which is totally different and divine – the power of mercy. It is mercy that puts an end to evil. Have faith he tells us, in Divine Mercy This feast emphasises the infinite mercy of God to all who repent of their sins.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

Monday:

St. Laserian (Molaise), bishop. He worked in Ireland and Scotland and became abbot of the monastery at Leighlin. He lived in the seventh century and adopted Roman practices and the Roman method of dating the celebration of Easter. At the Council of Nicea in 325 the date for Easter was fixed as the Sunday after the full moon after the spring Equinox. Eastern Christians still celebrate Easter according to the Julian Calendar

Thursday:

St. Anselm, bishop and doctor of the church. He was a monk in Normandy before becoming Archbishop of Canterbury. He was exiled twice and died in 1109.
