

Vernacular Heritage Trail Saturday 13th August 9am-1pm – The Neale, Ballinrobe, Partry. Organised by Joyce Country and Western Lakes GeoEnterprise, with funding from Mayo coco's Community Heritage Grant Scheme.

For National Heritage Week 2022, we are offering a tour and talk about our built vernacular heritage in three communities in south County Mayo within the aspiring UNESCO Global Geopark. We will film the talks as they take place at points of interest on the tour. Guided by local people with expertise on the architecturally significant constructs in their villages. There's plenty of scope for Q&A, and the resultant video can be shared. In The Neale, Joe Greaney will take the group through the Boycott story through a visit to the ruins of the estate of Lord Kilmaine; plus the historical features of the ball alley and deserted village of Ballywalter (time permitting). In Ballinrobe, Averil Staunton shows us Ballinrobe Canal and related architectural features from 1849 which was an attempt to link the region to the port of Galway. We also look at an intriguing cattle-loading ramp in the town, and the historic Creagh House (1875). At Cloonee (Partry), Paul Maguire shows us a well preserved blast furnace, part of the 18th-century industrial heritage of County Mayo. Logistics. Bus for up to 20 participants leaves at 9am from Partry Community Hall, returning there to finish at 1pm. Light refreshments provided along the way. Charge of €5/person for bus costs. 
