PENTECOST SUNDAY:

This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday when we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary. The fifty days of Easter conclude with the celebration of Pentecost Sunday. The coming of the Holy Spirit gives birth to the Church and its mission to all peoples and nations.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

- Monday:** The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church.
Wednesday: The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast celebrates the visit of the Blessed Virgin Mary to her cousin, Elizabeth to be of help to her in her pregnancy.
Thursday: St. Justin, martyr. He was born in the Holy Land but settled in Rome. He became a Christian and defended Christian belief and practice. He was martyred about 165 A.D.
Saturday: St. Kevin, abbot. He was born in Leinster. He became a hermit in Glendalough, Co. Wicklow but disciples gathered around him. A great monastic settlement developed in the glen after his death in 618.
