### Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday falls on the sixth and last Sunday of Lent. It marks the beginning of Holy Week. The gospels record the arrival of Jesus riding into the city on a donkey, while the crowds spread their cloaks and palm branches on the street and shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord".
