REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY:

Mass for the dead will be celebrated in Kilmaclasser Cemetery on this Sunday 25th June and in Kilmeena Old Cemetery on Sunday, 2nd July. Each of these Masses will be celebrated at 6.00pm.

These cemetery Masses will be celebrated if the weather is suitable. The cemetery Mass is a special occasion to remember your dead, especially those who died in the past year. Please ensure that your family plot and the area around it is clean and tidy for the occasion.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

Tuesday: St. Cyril of Alexandria, bishop and doctor of the church. (370-

444). He presided at the Council of Ephesus which condemned the Nestorian heresy and proclaimed that Mary is truly the Mother of

God.

Wednesday: St. Irenaeus, bishop and martyr. He lived just after the time of the

apostles and met people who knew them. He became bishop of Lyons, the largest centre in Gaul (modern France) at the time. He

tried to convert pagans to Christianity by love rather than fear.

Thursday: Sts. Peter and Paul, apostles. This day celebrates the twin

founders of the Church in Rome. St. Peter suffered martyrdom by

crucifixion and St. Paul was beheaded two years later.

Friday: The First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church – all these in addition

to Sts Peter and Paul who were martyred under Nero in the year 64

Saturday: St. Oliver Plunkett, bishop, and martyr. He was appointed

Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. He had to conduct a covert ministry because of the suppression of priests. In 1679 he was arrested for conspiring against the state, tried in London and suffered a

gruesome death at Tyburn on 1st July 1681
