You are invited to a special 60^{th} anniversary commemoration of the Glencorrib Church Bell in Glencorrib Church this **Sunday 8th October @ 2pm.** The commemorative event will bring us together to celebrate our faith, our Church, our Bell, our history, and the spirit of generosity within our community. 60 years ago, in 1963 John Harte of Mounthenry donated £500 towards the cost of the bell and tower in memory of his brother James Harte who passed away in 1960. Autumn Dues – Thank You for Your Continuing Support

Autumn Dues envelopes are now available at the back of the church for those who do not use the envelope system. If you are using the envelopes available at church, and are planning to apply for charity tax rebate, please write your name and envelope number on envelope.

What are Dues Envelopes?

The Autumn Dues envelopes along with Christmas and Autumn Dues pay the **salary of the priest** of the parish, diocesan levy (calculated by curates' salary) and contribute to the **support of** retired clergy, clergy working in offices and clergy in underprivileged areas of the diocese. The current salary for the priest of the diocese is €1450 per calendar month.

What is the Weekly Offertory Collection for then?

It is a common misunderstanding that the weekly offertory collection is for the priest. In actually fact, the weekly offertory collections is for the upkeep and running of the parish. It does not form any part of the priest's income or salary.
