Wednesday: St. John of God, religious. (1495-1550). He devoted his life to the

care of the poor and the sick.

Thursday: St. Frances of Rome, religious. She lived a happily married life in

Rome where she worked hard for the poor. She died in 1440.

Saturday: St. Aengus, bishop and abbot. He was abbot and bishop of the

monastery in Clonenaghy, Co. Laois in the eighth century. He had great devotion to native and foreign saints. He died about 830.
