Church Re-Opening:

- 1: As you enter the Church you will be met by a steward who will take you to your seat. For the moment you will not be able to automatically go to your usual seat. Please sanitise your hands as you enter the Church.
- 2: The use of face coverings is now mandatory.
- **3:** Social Distancing is now reduced to 1 metre within the church, members of the same household can occupy a single seat as before. A maximum of 50 % of church seating capacity may now be used for a mass, a wedding or a funeral.
- **4:** Parish Newsletters will be only available at both exits of the Church.
- 5: Holy Communion will be distributed after mass as people proceed to the exit doors.
- **6:** Holy Communion can be received in the hands only.
- 7: People who have attended mass outside of the Church may enter the Church to receive Holy Communion at the end of Mass.
- **8**: From Sundays to Thursdays the Church will be closed at 7pm.
