THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD:

St. Maximus of Turin in the fourth century set the birth and baptism of the Lord side by side as equal reasons for joy: He said 'At Christmas, Christ's mother, Mary, held him close to her heart. Today, God the Father embraces Christ'. This feast is a continuation of the Epiphany and the conclusion of the Christmas season. The Baptism is also an epiphany, a revelation of Christ's divine nature.

Jesus entered the river of life to associate with all sinners and set them at rights with God. What happened on that day at the Jordan river may be understood as the divine call to Jesus to commence his mission.
