PARISH NEWS:

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

Tuesday: St. Aidan, bishop. He was born in 550 in Co. Cavan. He studied under David in Wales and on returning to Ireland founded a monastery in Ferns, Co. Wexford. He became bishop and was renowned for his generosity and kindness. He died in 626.

Wednesday: St. John Bosco, priest (1815-1888). He was born in Piedmont, Italy and founded the Salesian order to educate boys for life. He is patron saint of youth.

Thursday: St. Bridget, virgin, secondary patron of Ireland (454-525). She founded a double monastery in Kildare for men and women. Hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick were her main preoccupations. Her reputation for holiness earned her the title 'Mary of the Gael'

Friday: The Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas Day). On this day (40 days after his birth) Jesus was presented in the Temple and Simeon proclaimed him 'the light to enlighten the pagans'. At baptism we receive a lighted candle and promise to show the light of Christ to all around us by the kind of life we live.

Saturday: St. Blaise. He was martyred in Armenia in 315. He saved a young boy one time who got a bone stuck in his throat. He is now venerated as Patron Saint of Sore Throats.

The Pope has asked that the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord be celebrated as 'The Day for Consecrated Life'. We are asked to pray for and foster vocations to the priesthood and religious life on this day.
