The location is 1 hour from Galway city, and 30 minutes from Westport, Castlebar and Ballinrobe. The event starts at 6pm on 1st August. This year the event will be run in the opposite direction to previous years to give the runners and walkers a chance to catch their breath as the steep "Maloney Hill" will be a descent at the end rather than an ascent at the start.
