FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

Monday: **St. Barnabas, apostle.** He came from Cyprus and was one of the first converts in Jerusalem. He preached at Antioch and was a companion of St. Paul on his first missionary journey. He later preached in Cyprus and died there.

Wednesday: **St. Anthony of Padua, priest and doctor of the church.** He died in Padua in 1231, aged 36 years. He was a Franciscan and preached against heresy in France and Italy.

Thursday: **St. Davnet, virgin.** She lived and died at Tydavnet in Co. Monaghan. She is said to have founded a church or monastery.
