PARISH NEWS:

CORPUS CHRISTI:

The feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) falls on this Sunday, 23rd June and the Corpus Christi Procession with the Blessed Sacrament will be held after the 11.30am Mass in Myna, (weather permitting). You are invited to take part in the Procession to Myna Cemetery and back to the church so that you can give public witness to your belief in the Blessed Sacrament. When carried in procession in this way Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament blesses all who live in our parish, our homes and our places of work.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

- Monday:** **The Birth of St. John the Baptist.** He prepared the way for Our Saviour, Jesus Christ. He lived a life of self-denial in the desert and was uncompromising in denouncing evil and immorality.
- Thursday:** **St. Cyril of Alexandria, bishop and doctor of the church. (370-444).** He presided at the Council of Ephesus which condemned the Nestorian heresy and proclaimed that Mary is truly the Mother of God.
- Friday:** **The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.**
- Saturday:** **Sts. Peter and Paul, apostles.** This day celebrates the twin founders of the Church in Rome. St. Peter suffered martyrdom by crucifixion and St. Paul was beheaded two years later.
